

2017 TCR EUROPEAN TROPHY

Regulations

FOREWORD

TCR SA, promoter of the TCR International Series, is organizing the 2017 TCR European Trophy reserved for TCR car

1) EVENT

The 2017 TCR European Trophy is made up of one single event that will be held on 28th and 29th October 2017 at Adria Raceway, Italy.

2) ELIGIBLE DRIVERS:

Only the Drivers and Competitors who did take part in at least one TCR event during the 2017 season are eligible to Qualify for the 2017 TCR European Trophy.

To the Drivers who have qualified as per the first Team Info, Pre-qualifying points will be allocated according to the number of events in which they took part, up to a maximum of 5 points (see art. 8 & 9).

The Drivers classified in the first ten positions of the 2017 TCR International Series, as per 30 September 2017, are not eligible to Qualify for the 2017 TCR European Trophy.

3) WILD CARDS

TCR SA reserves the right to allocate Wild Card entries.

4) SPORTING REGULATIONS

The Sporting Regulations for the 2017 TCR European Trophy final event in Adria will be published by 18th September 2017.

5) LICENCES

The FIA 'C' International Driver's licence is required to take part in the 2017 TCR European Trophy final event in Adria.

6) ENTRY FEE

Entries will open on 1st September 2017.

The entry fee for the 2017 TCR Europe Trophy final event in Adria is set at € 4,000 per car.

7) EVENT FORMAT

a) Up to 32 entries, the Event format will be the following:

- two Free Practice sessions of 30 minutes each
- one Qualifying session split in two parts: Q1 (30 min) + interval (5 min) + Q2 (15 min for the 12 fastest cars in Q1)
- two Races of 25 minutes + 1 lap each

The Starting Grid for Race 1 will be based on the final combined results of the Qualifying session. The Starting Grid for Race 2 will be based on the final combined results of the Qualifying session, with the first ten Drivers placed in reverse order.

b) In case of more than 32 entries, the Drivers will be split in two groups by the Promoter and the Event format will be the following:

- two Free Practice sessions of 30 minutes (one per each group)
- two Qualifying sessions of 20 minutes (one per each group)
- two Qualifying races of 20 minutes + 1 lap (one per each group)
- one Repechage race of 20 minutes + 1 lap
- one Final race of 35 minutes + 1 lap

The Starting Grid for the Final Race will be determined by the sum of Pre-qualifying and Qualifying Race points scored by the Drivers (see art. 9).

The Driver who has scored the highest number of points in the fastest Qualifying Race will be on pole position, with the Drivers classified from 2nd to 10th forming the line behind the pole position.

The Drivers classified from 1st to 10th in the slowest Qualifying Race will form the other line.

The Drivers who failed to qualify for the Final Race through the Qualifying Races will take part in one Repechage Race of 20 minutes.

The Drivers classified from 1st to 6th in the Repechage Race will fill the position from 21st to 26th.

8) DRIVERS' POINT SCORING SYSTEM – EVENT FORMAT A

Drivers taking part in the 2017 TCR European Trophy will score points according to the following:

Pre-qualifying points

- 1 point per event will be allocated to each Driver who did take part in any events of the 2017 TCR Regional/National Series or Championships, up to a maximum of 5 points
- 1 point per event will be allocated to each Driver who did take part in any of the European events of the 2017 TCR International Series

Points awarded in the Qualifying session

The final classification of the 2017 TCR European Trophy for Drivers will take into account the sum of the Pre-qualifying, Qualifying and Race points.

9) DRIVERS' POINT SCORING SYSTEM – EVENT FORMAT B

Drivers taking part in the 2017 TCR European Trophy will score points only to qualify for the Final race according to the following:

Pre-qualifying points

- 1 point per event will be allocated to each Driver who did take part in any events of the 2017 TCR Regional/National Series or Championships, up to a maximum of 5 points
- 1 point per event will be allocated to each Driver who did take part in any of the European events of the 2017 TCR International Series

Points awarded in each Qualifying Race

The Qualification for the Final Race will take into account the sum of Pre-qualifying, and Qualifying Race points.

The ten best scoring Drivers of each Qualifying race will qualify for the Final Race.

10) TEAMS' POINT SCORING SYSTEM – EVENT FORMAT A

Teams taking part in the 2017 TCR European Trophy will score points according to the following:

Points awarded in each Race

The final classification of the 2017 TCR European Trophy for Teams will take into account the sum of points scored by the best two cars classified of each Team.

11) TEAMS' POINT SCORING SYSTEM – EVENT FORMAT B

Teams taking part in the 2017 TCR European Trophy will score points according to the following:

Points awarded in the Final Race

The final classification of the 2017 TCR European Trophy for Teams will take into account the sum of the points scored by the best two cars classified of each Team.

12) AWARDS

The 2017 TCR Europe Trophies will be awarded to the first three Drivers and to the first Team classified in the final classification.

13) PRIZES

The winning Driver of the 2017 TCR European Trophy will be awarded with a TCR road car. Further details will be unveiled in due course.

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
